# Financial Aid Policies

Financial aid requirements described in the financial aid policy (*policy number BO-SFS.8.1.5*) are applicable for the **Middle East Scholars Aid**, with the exception of the age limit. Students of all ages are eligible to apply for the Middle East Scholars Aid.

Financial Aid is applied **for 60 ECTS credits** per academic year. If you take more than 60 ECTS credits per academic year the award will not be increased.

Students must be enrolled in at least 24 credit hours per semester to receive an award. If a student enrolls in less than 24 credit hours in either semester, they will not receive their financial aid for that semester.

Students can receive **only one award.** If a student qualifies for more than one, he/she will receive the one with the highest monetary value, and the other award will go to the next student who qualifies.

If the student has received any financial aid and has been placed on **probation** after the first semester, he/she does not receive the financial aid part that has been allocated for the second semester.

If a student receives financial aid and then decides to take an **academic leave**, he/she loses the award. The student is then informed of the dates for financial aid application for the next academic year.

Students can get financial grants **only for five years at LCC or up to 10 semesters**, PRIME program included (*calculation would be done by semesters if a student takes an academic leave*). If students study longer or take a second major, they must find their own financing opportunities.

Students receiving financial aid that withdraw or stop attending classes will be required to return financial aid received.

Middle East Scholar Aid recipients are eligible to receive aid for **Summer courses.** 

Only Middle East Scholars Aid recipients **living in LCC provided housing** are eligible to receive monthly stipends. If a student lives outside LCC provided housing, monthly stipends are not issued to such students.

MES students that receive full tuition and full housing discount will receive **bedding in housing free of charge.** When possible, a small set of dishes will also be provided for their use.

Middle East Scholars Aid is awarded to **one individual** per nuclear and extended family. With the Middle East Scholars Aid, LCC assists students experiencing financial difficulties from the war-affected countries such as Syria, Iraq and Afghanistan (and possibly other war affected areas). Exceptions could be made for female siblings of the same family.

All Financial Aid at LCC International University is based on **availability of funds.** Therefore, students and their families must take primary responsibility for meeting the costs of education at LCC International University.

## MES (NB Aid)

To receive NB Aid for 2024-2025 you will have to go through the following steps:

STEP#1 Check your eligibility. Please see the detailed list of eligible countries below:

Middle East Scholars Aid is a need-based aid that aims to assist war-affected students from Syria, Iraq, Iran, Afghanistan, Myanmar (Burma), Yemen, Ethiopia, Sudan (and possibly other war affected areas, such as South-Eastern Asia: Cambodia, Laos).

**STEP #2 Fill out and submit** this form together with supporting documents to Student Financial Services office #23 (Defehr).

The application is considered as complete, if:

- the application is completely and correctly filled out,
- all required documents with official translations (if applicable) are attached.
- all required documents are official (no photocopies or scanned documents),
- all required documents represent information for the recent 12 months period.

### APPLICATION DEADLINE:

November 15, 2023 (PRIME - Junior). Late NB Aid application forms will not be accepted.

TIPS TO REMEMBER when filling out a NB Aid application:

Application must be filled out in English.

**Documents** should be submitted **in Lithuanian or English** only. If your documents are in a different language, please submit an official translation together with the original document.

**Only official documents** will be accepted. A document is considered as official, if it has an institution's that issued the document stamp and its representative's signature.

All financial information must be completed in the student's national currency or in euros.

Do not leave any questions blank. If your answer is 0, please use a "0".

If a question does not apply to you, please use the abbreviation "N/A". Incomplete information may delay the processing of your application.

The completed application becomes the **confidential property of LCC** and is not returnable. Applicants are responsible for ensuring that all the information and accompanying material provided in connection with their application is **authentic and accurate.** FALSELY REPRESENTED INFORMATION WILL VOID FINANCIAL AID AND COMPROMISE YOUR STANDING AS A STUDENT AT LCC INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY.

LCC may at any time require applicants to provide **satisfactory verification** of the information and documents submitted as part of their application. If an applicant is unable to do so, the University reserves the right to cease consideration of the application and to withdraw any offer of financial aid already made.

Only complete MES NB Aid applications with required documentation will be processed.

### STEP #3 Interview.

Returning students will be invited for an interview with the Student Financial Services Director. Interviews will be conducted with students over October 2023-January 2024 period. You will be informed about the exact date and time in advance. If you miss the interview, the Need-Based Aid Committee will not proceed with your application form.

### STEP #4 Decision.

Middle East Scholar Aid (NB Aid) 2024-2025 decisions will be announced by the end of March 2024.
